

Mayor Fred Froehlich called the workshop to order at 5:30 p.m. on April 19, 2023 in the Council Chambers.

Members and guests sited the words to the Pledge of Allegiance.

In addition to Mayor Froehlich; Councilmembers: Mary Wels, Matt Anthony, Phil Radel and Kevin Ostermann were present. Others in attendance included Vanessa Drill, Ryan Asmus and Andrew Cotton with Lapointe Utilities, Zach Raskovich, Bob Frazer and Theresa Sunde with Mediacom, and Sheriff Dave Lange.

The purpose of the workshop was for Mediacom to present their intensions with the broadband fiber to the premise build and for a discussion with the Nicollet County Sheriff on the parking ordinance.

Mediacom presented the fiber to the premises project that will make broadband internet services with Gigabit speeds available to 556 existing homes and businesses within the community. Some of the project will consist of setting new pedestals and new cabinets, boring and pulling fiber through. Mediacom is new to the area.

Discussion with the sheriff about what other cities do with contracting with their county law enforcement for those that do not have a police department. In order for the sheriff's department to help enforce some of the city ordinance's an agreement would need to be set up between the sheriff's department and the city. Also, discussion of what other cities charge for fines on parking ordinances and the process.
