

ORDINANCE #164
An Ordinance Setting the Salaries for the Mayor and City Council

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NICOLLET:

SECTION 1. The terms “Regular Meetings” and “Special Meetings” refer to city council meetings called pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 412.191, subd. 2. The term “Public Hearing” refers to any hearing required under state statute; this included but is not limited to assessment hearings, truth in taxation hearings, zoning amendments, and applications for conditional use permits and variances. The term “Representative Meeting” refers to any non-council meeting that is attended by the mayor or city council members on behalf of the city council; this includes but is not limited to the meetings of joint powers boards and of the economic development authority.

SECTION 2. The salary of the mayor of the City of Nicollet shall be \$208.33 per meeting for regular council meetings, whether attended or not. In addition, the mayor shall be paid \$75.00 for attendance of each special meeting, representative meeting, and public hearing.


SECTION 3. The salary of each city council member shall be \$166.67 per meeting for regular council meetings, whether attended or not. In addition, each city council member shall be paid \$65.00 for attendance of each special meeting, representative meeting, and public hearing.

SECTION 4. The effective date of this ordinance and the salaries provided hereby shall be January 1, 2023.

SECTION 5. Ordinance #129, “Setting the Salaries for the Mayor and Members of the City Council,” dated February 8, 2006, is hereby repealed.
